Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital COVID and Masking Protocols

In guidance with the host hospital, the Ronald McDonald Family Room abides by the hospital's COVID protocol and masking protocol.

Exposure or Testing Positive for COVID:

- If **exposed to someone** with COVID (household, unmasked interaction, etc.):
 - o Stay home from volunteering for 5 days and no fever with symptoms subsiding.
- If you **test positive** for COVID:
 - Please stay home for seven full days from onset of symptoms.
- Flu and other Respiratory Illnesses: There is not a set # of days yet determined to stay home from volunteering, but for sure 24 hours after any fever and symptoms have improved.

Masking Protocol:

Effective: Wednesday, March 15th, SSM and CGCH will be *masks optional*.

- For all employees, volunteers, and guests masking will be optional for all in the shuttles, hallways, café, Ronald McDonald Family Room, and in most areas/depts/units, with most patients.
- There will remain a few units that may require masking and there will always be those patients who need us to remain masked when in their rooms or when we are working with them 1:1.
- We also ask that if you are interacting with a family, patient, or another staff member and they ask you to mask during that interaction, please do so.
- Please be kind and patient with all who may not be aware as they enter the hospital for the first time after this goes into effect – Wednesday, March 15th.
